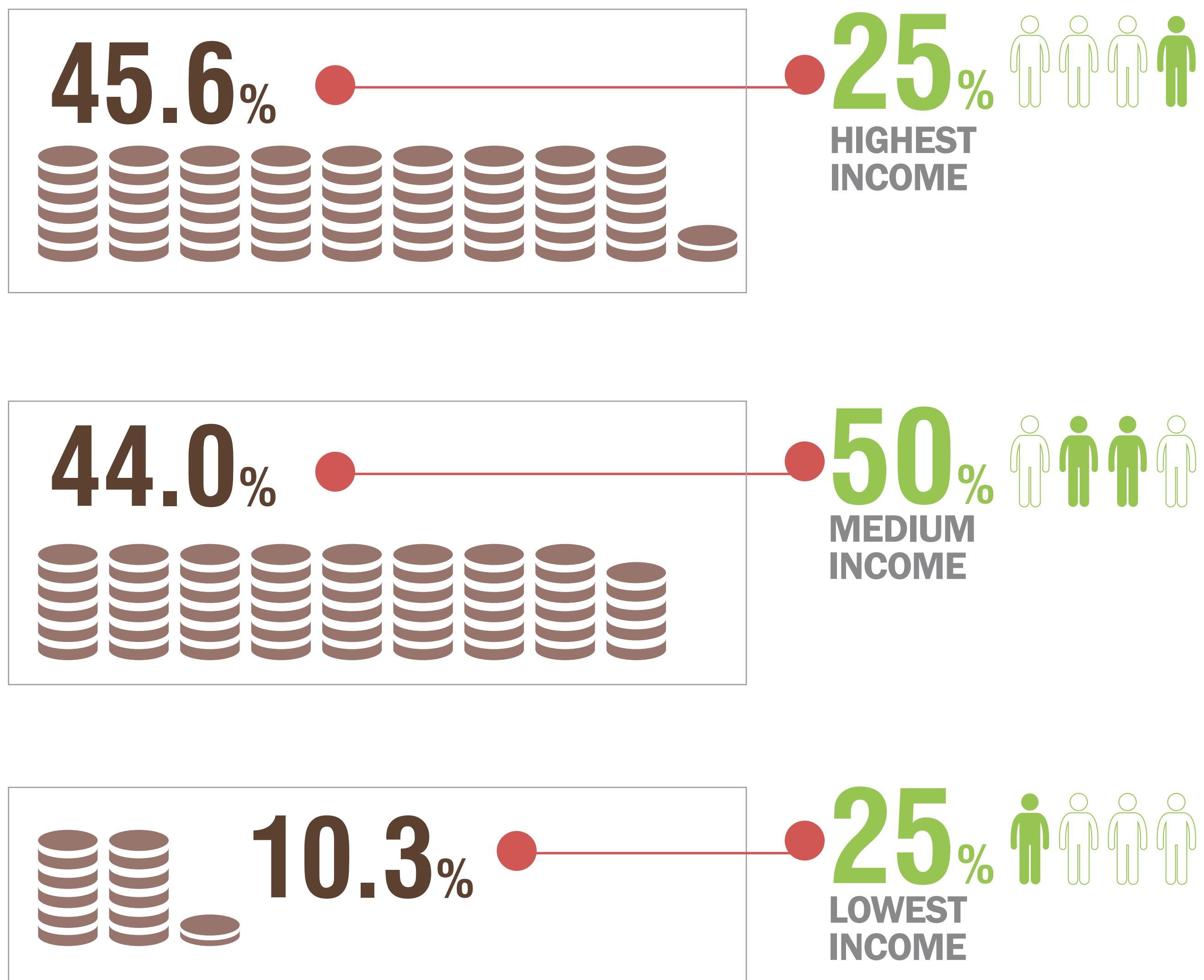

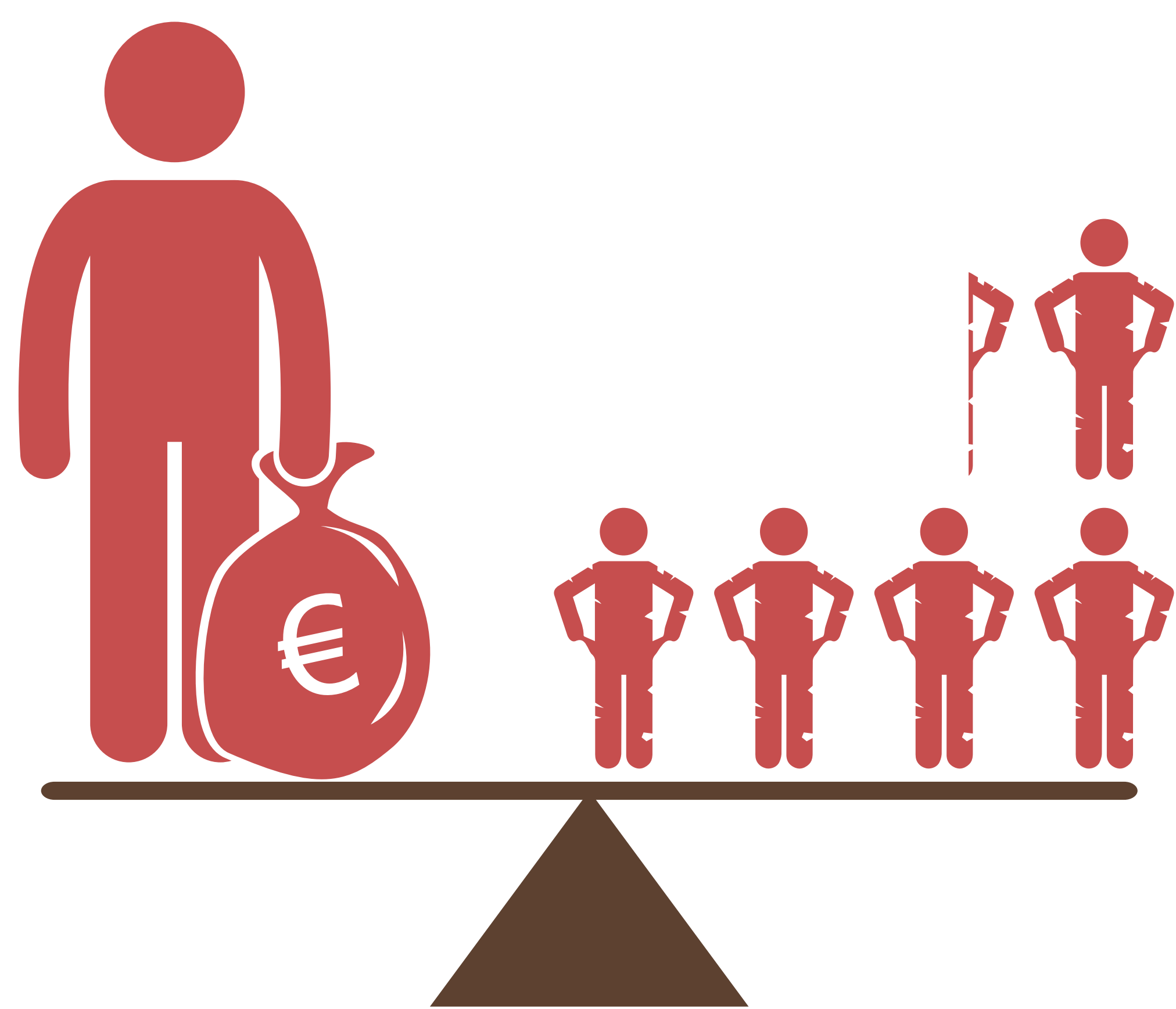
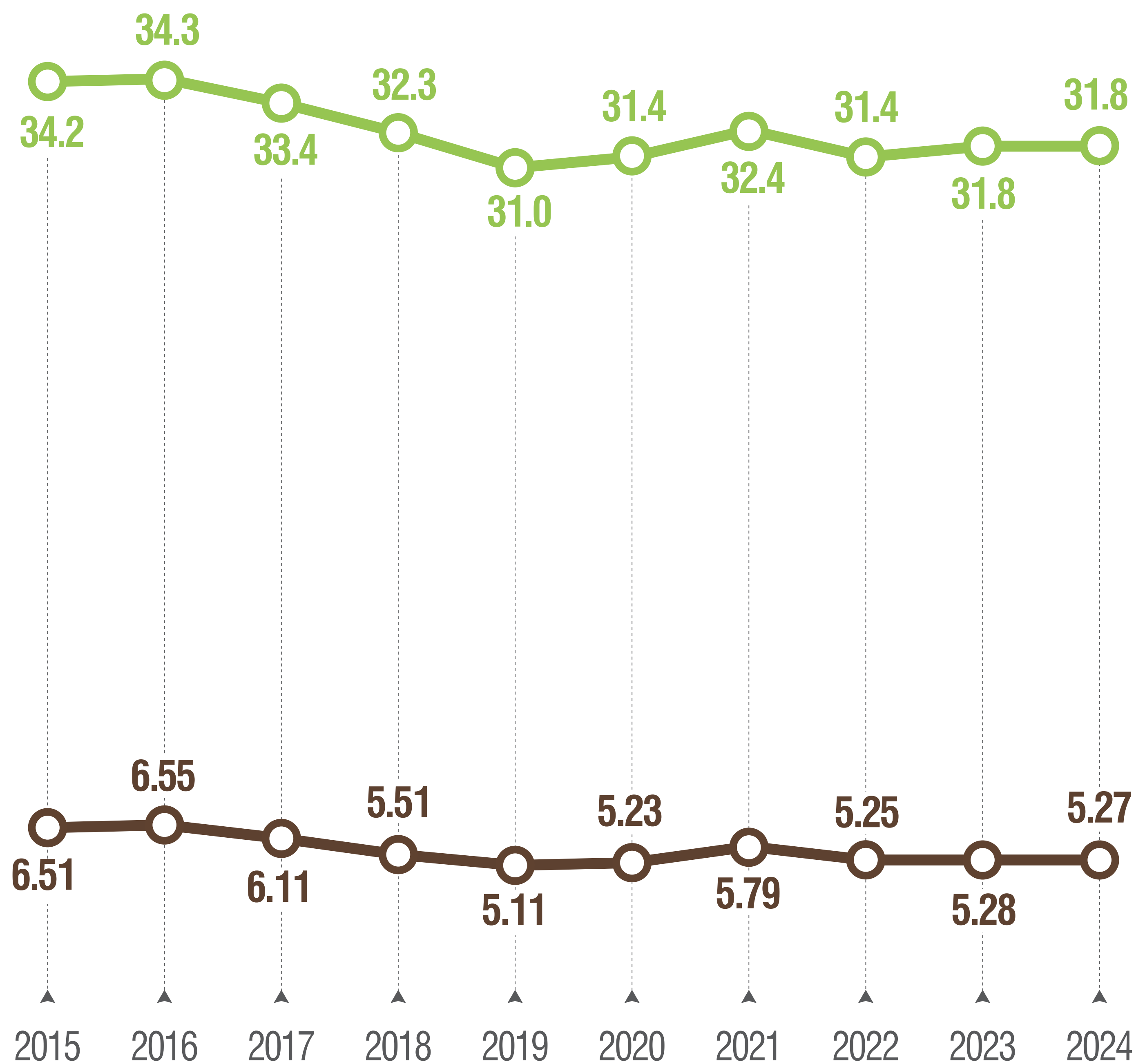

INDICATORS



GINI

Gini coefficient is the ratio of cumulative shares of the population arranged according to the level of equivalised disposable income to the cumulative share of the total equivalised disposable income received by them.

For 2024, if we choose randomly 2 persons, the difference between their income is expected to amount to 31.8% of the average equivalised disposable income.

S80/S20

The S80/S20 income quintile share ratio is the ratio of the total of equivalised disposable income received by the wealthiest 20% of the population to that received by the poorest 20% of the population.

In 2024 the share of the income of the wealthiest 20% of the population is 5.27 times higher than the share of the income of the poorest 20% of the population.

THE INCOME OF THE WEALTHIEST 20% OF THE POPULATION IS 5.27 TIMES HIGHER THAN THE INCOME OF THE POOREST 20%.
